Dear Parents / Carers

Apologies for the late email containing key worker information. As I am sure you can appreciate, it has been a very busy day as we review risk assessments and plan for remote education and for key worker children / vulnerable children in school.

We have approximately 90 children requesting a place in school tomorrow. The arrangements are as follows:

- School will operate as it did before Christmas.
- Children will remain in their same class bubble.
- Staffing will be consistent to minimise transmission.
- Children should come dressed in their school uniform or if it is their PE day, their PE kit.
- A school lunch can be provided as per usual or children can bring their own packed lunch.

We recognise that there are sometimes too many people on the yard at a given time making social distancing difficult. We are therefore asking the following:

- Please only enter the school site at your allocated time. Please do not enter the site if you arrive early.
- Only one adult per child.
- **Adults should wear a face covering when on site.** Children do not need to wear a face covering.
- If you are collecting more than one child, please arrive for the later time and do not wait on the yard.
- We have changed some of the exit points and timings to try and prevent groups of people trying to exit the site at the same time.
