


This is a guide for what will happen in the event of a class bubble or school is asked to Self Isolate.

If a single pupil is asked to self isolate then all the work will appear on the Google Classroom for that pupil. The class teacher will communicate with you during the time that the child is isolating.

If the class or school is asked to self isolate then the majority of the work will still appear on the Google Classroom as usual. However, in addition there will be a short introduction to the English task via an Online Video Link. This will happen to allow a better understanding of the task that has been set and also to allow the teacher to have some visual contact with the class. This has been seen to be important to help maintain the well-being of the pupils.

Online Video Lessons

The work, as for other subjects, will be outlined on the Google Classroom for the day. To help the English lesson, there will be an Online Video link using Google Meet. This will last approximately 10-15 mins. The teacher will put up the time that the video link will happen in an assignment on the Google Classroom.

Before the video Meeting.

Please make sure that the pupil is dressed - they should not be in pyjamas.
Please make sure that the background is suitable for others to see.
We ask that a parent/carer is around during the Video Meeting

At the correct time, the pupil should click on the Class Video meeting Link.

This will open up Google Meet.
Please can the video be turned on, but the microphone be muted.
The lesson must not be recorded onto any device.

At the end of the Video Meeting

The teacher will ensure that all pupils have left the meeting and the meeting will be closed.
The English task, which will be within the Google Classroom should then be done.

Live Online Lessons

During Live online lessons with your teachers it is really important that you keep to the following rules:

1. An adult is with you during the video call
2. You are in either your dining room, living room or kitchen and not your bedroom.
3. You must be dressed and ready – not in pyjamas.
4. Please remember that the live online lesson is part of school. You must be respectful to staff and other pupils. School rules still apply!
5. Please make sure you are muted, unless your teacher asks you to unmute.
6. The lesson will be about 10-15 minutes long and will introduce you to the lesson and then your teacher will set you off on a task to complete. You will do this after the live lesson has ended.
7. Each lesson will be repeated twice a day to allow you to select which time is best for you and your family. The slides will then be available, as usual, on the Google Classroom.
8. The lesson is for us only and you must not record it.

If you have any questions your teacher can be contacted by sending a message over the Google Classroom.
