Please find below upcoming information for a very exciting week in school:

Nasal Flu vaccinations

The school nursing team will be administering nasal flu vaccinations to those children whose parents have given consent tomorrow, Tuesday 16th November.

Wednesday 17th November - School's Centenary birthday

We are asking that children come **dressed to school in their party clothes** and **bring their own 'party plate'** to enjoy in the afternoon.

We will begin the day by gathering outside for a short assembly, where we will open our birthday cards, sing happy birthday and blow out the candles. We will also sing our special centenary song written by Year 5.

During the remainder of day, we have timetabled the hall so the children can play some party games and at other times work on their centenary class projects.

Thursday 18th November - School in the 1920s

The children will be experiencing what school was like 100 years ago. Children can come dressed in their current school uniform or period dress e.g. *School uniform typical of 1921 can be worn but not essential e.g. waistcoat / pinafore / hat / cap etc*
